BFI Southbank Student Study Day

On Tuesday 13th June the MFL department are running a trip to BFI Southbank.

Thank you for contributing towards the trip and permitting your child to attend. The day will use Spanish short films as a stimulus, the morning session will screen a range of films suitable for KS3 pupils, alongside interactive activities. This is a great opportunity for pupils to learn more about Spanish culture through the study of film, as well as developing their Spanish vocabulary and speaking skills.

Pupils need to register with their period 1 teacher and come down to Reception to leave at 9am.
