Ice Skating and Christmas Activities

As a celebration of Christmas, we will be taking Year 12 and 13 students ice-skating on Monday 12th December. The cost is £14.85 per student, which must be paid via ParentPay.

We will take the students to the ice rink outside Battersea Power Station, travelling by tube from Southfields. We propose to leave school at 2.50pm in time to change into skates to begin the session at 4pm. After the session, students will be dismissed from the ice-skating rink.

Students should wear sensible clothes and bring gloves. They should have a topped-up Zip Card to pay for the journey. School bags must not be taken to the ice-rink; there is insufficient storage at the venue.

We have managed to secure 50 slots, and these will be allocated on first come, first served basis.


There will be an option on Parent Pay to overpay for a ticket in a Pay It Forward manner to enable students who might not otherwise be able to join in.
