Year 10 Business Studies

As part of their WJEC Business Studies course, we have arranged to take the Year 10 Business Studies class to Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Museum. The pupils will take part in an interactive lecture to look at how a major sporting event runs as a business. Real world examples of marketing, finance and external influences on business will be covered in the sessions, along with a shortened tour of the tennis club and a museum visit.

We will leave school at 9.30am and walk to Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Club. The session will finish at 2pm, so we will be back in school by 2.30pm. Pupils will go to mentor time or assembly as normal when we get back.

To cover the cost of the event, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £6 per pupil. There are no other funds to cover the cost of the trip, and so if insufficient funds are received, the trip may need to be cancelled. Pupils in receipt of Free School Meals will have the cost of the trip covered by the department.

Transport: Walk to Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Museum from school

Time of return: 2.30pm arrival back at school. Pupils will go to mentor time/assembly as normal.

Required equipment: School uniform as normal, pencil case, a calculator, packed lunch and a bottle of water.

Cost: £6

Pupils in receipt of Free School Meals should collect their packed lunch from the Refectory in the morning prior to departure.

Please provide your permission for your child to attend the trip and make the voluntary contribution via ParentPay by Friday 27th January 2023.
