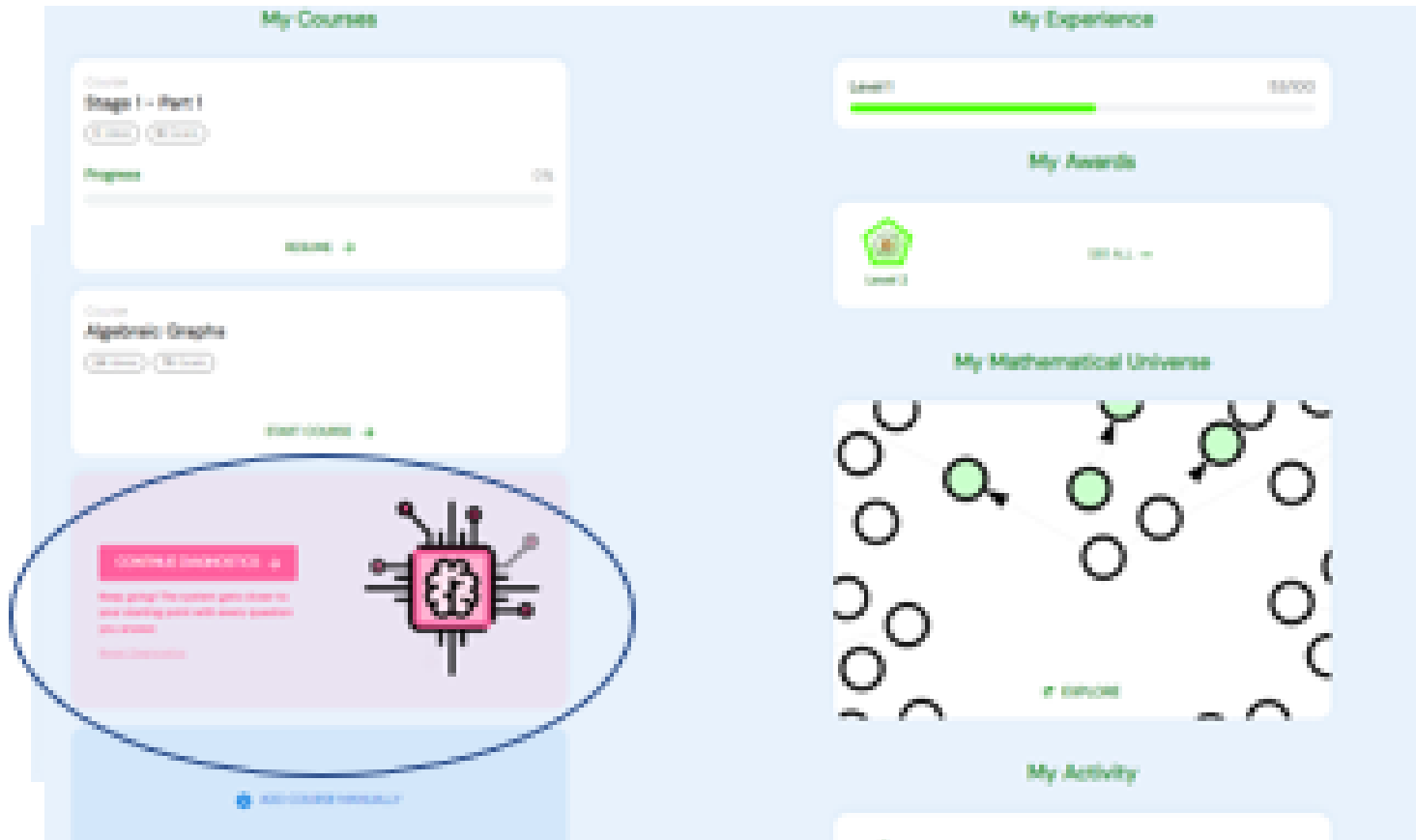
Your login is the first part of your school email address before @.

Example: If your school email is
20PeterSmith@Saintcecilias.london

Then your Completemaths Tutor login is **20PeterSmith**

Password is **circle** (all lower case)

Start with the diagnostic tests



The diagnostic tests will lead you to guidance and help in the areas you need to practise.

1. After the first diagnostic test, you will get a score.
2. Return to the dashboard, and continue with the diagnostic tests – note it will always start off with the easy questions and get progressively harder.
3. Keep returning to **continue to diagnostic questions** until it says “Brilliant” and that is when it knows enough about you to guide you to strengthen your knowledge. At this point you click on “add” to your course.
